Your Pathway to Career Advancement



Increase your English language proficiency while gaining professional skills and academic credit in our newly revised **10-week Intensive English Program**. As the global workspace continues to evolve, it's essential to build up your English language skills to set yourself apart from the rest. Your newly acquired skills can be beneficial for university admission, attaining career goals, and increasing your intercultural communication skills. Be the person who gets the next promotion!

PROGRAM ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

The Intensive English Plus program is open to students of all language levels, from beginner to advanced. Upon admission to the program, all students must complete an English proficiency test before arriving on campus. We provide a free Duolingo English Test with a code given to admitted students. However, students may also choose to submit IELTS or TOEFL scores if they prefer. Test results will be used to determine the correct introductory level for each student.

HOW THE PROGRAM WORKS

Practice essential language skills like listening, speaking, reading, grammar, and writing, while simultaneously taking academic credit coursework* from our Specialized Professional Program in Supervision and Leadership to further develop your professional skills. Upon completion of the program, you will have earned up to 2 units of academic credit and can choose to stay in the US and continue taking courses in the Specialized Professional Program in Supervision and Leadership to earn the full certificate or return to your home country and finish the certificate online. Ideally, you could complete the entire Specialized Professional Program in Supervision and Leadership within just ONE academic year.**

This full-time immersion program offers seven levels, from 100 (beginner) to 300 (low intermediate) to 700 (proficient). Courses offered in levels 300-400 focus on intercultural skills, and courses in levels 500-700 focus on certificate courses from the Specialized Professional Program in Supervision and Leadership.

* Courses are subject to change.

** Students must begin at a minimum of Level 500, and enroll in one additional class during their final quarter to reach this goal.
