




How to Create a Video-based Discussion in Canvas

Tutorial Summary: Video-based discussion is a great way to create a multisensory learning experience for students in the course. This tutorial will show you two options to upload a video to Canvas discussion. Option #1 will show you how to upload a prerecorded video to the discussion. Option #2 will show you how to record directly from your webcam and upload it to the discussion.

Option #1: Upload a prerecorded video to Canvas Discussion

Step 1


Click on the **Reply** button of the discussion and select the **Insert** tab (A). Go to **Media** (B) and choose **Upload/Record Media** (C).



Step 2

On the Upload Media popup window, make sure **Computer** is selected (A).


Click on the rocket icon (B) or drag the prerecorded video file to the area inside the red square to upload your file and post your reply.



Option #2: Record a Video and Upload It Directly to Canvas Discussion


Step 1

Click on the **Reply** button of the discussion and select the **Insert** tab (A). Go to **Media** (B) and choose **Upload/Record Media** (C).



Step 2

On the Upload Media popup window, make sure **Record** is selected (A). Click on **Start Recording** (B) to begin the recording using your computer webcam.



Step 3

When you are done with your recording, you will need to give it a name (A).
Afterward, click **Save Media** (B) and post your reply.
